The 2nd team, again under the captaincy of the experienced Danny Morgans began the season in Division 2 with high expectations. The disappointment of relegation at the end of 2015 was soon forgotten as the side began to build and attempt a return to first division cricket at the first time of asking.

An early season car accident meant Ollie King was missing from the bowling attack. He was a big miss after being a key figure last season. His absence and consequent injuries to Morgans, Barker and Matty Morgans meant several younger players were given opportunities to prove their mettle at this level.

Some showed they have what it takes whilst others struggled somewhat. It is important to listen top advice from senior players and work at aspects of your game that need improving at higher levels.

With six or seven of the team now in their late thirties/early forties the search for new players is important. The bulk of the runs were again scored by the experienced batsmen; Morgans, Lethbridge C, Barker, Baldwin, Peacock and Whitehead. Morgans finishing 8th in the league averages, Lethbridge 11th.

The bowling fell to two more "oldies" with Mark Stainsby and Shaughn Russell being the two bowlers taking more than 30 wickets. Russell was again impressive. Having retired last year and come back he again had a great season taking wickets. He finished 3rd in the Division 2 league averages. Stainsby was 6th

Jack Hardy took over wicket keeping duties having re joined the club in the winter. He finished 5th in the league keepers stats. Adam Baldwin was left to concentrate on his batting. Jonathan Pears having been selected for the North of England Under 15s was selected during the summer and batted half a dozen times. His 155 runs came at an average of 31 and included one half century. Hopefully he will repay the club's confidence in his ability in 2017 with some outstanding performances.

With three games to go and only one team gaining promotion we still had an outside chance of catching leaders, Darlington RA. We played them in a win or bust penultimate fixture of the season at Brinkburn Road. We didn't play to our full ability however and were defeated, losing any outside chance of promotion, this season at least. Our final game of the season was an emphatic victory at home with Andy Peacock scoring an excellent half century.

A good season overall however, despite the injuries sustained by some of the side who are beginning to realise that these minor pulls and strains take longer to heal the older you get. The group of "younger senior" players pulled together in the absence of the injured few and took the added responsibility well. Andy Peacock led the

side in Morgans absence well and Baldwin and Lethbridge were among the top players in the league. Hardy was amongst the leading keepers in the division. Promotion in 2017? Don't bet against it!

The group of cricketers in the 15 to 20 aged category with aspirations to succeed at this level must take a serious look at their own game and review how they can look to improve the skills that got them selected in the first place. A cricketer is never the finished article.
